Curriculum/syllabus development – national automotive manufacturer dealership sales strategy training for several manufacturers, vehicle testing procedures manual, instructor and mechanic training manuals for 180 staff, customer service representative descriptive scripting, video production scripting, numerous published papers, articles, broadcast media appearances, program proposal preparation.

Instruction/training/coaching – racing and driving school events, providing classroom “chalk talks” and individualized instruction in the technology, techniques and improvement of competent behavior and performance in the driver/automobile interface. In-car coaching and demonstration driving. 40+ U.S. locations (85events/yr.)

“Ride and Drive” programs – team leader, event coordinator for manufacturer-sponsored driving events for “product launch”; new car demonstrations, sales training and product comparison. Many individual events, several national tours, two international (Canada, snow and Dubai, desert). (market dependent, dozens of locations)
